Embark on an unforgettable journey to Prathat Doi Suthep Temple, a place of immense historical and spiritual significance, as well as a popular tourist destination. Revered as one of Thailand's most sacred temples, it sits majestically atop Doi Suthep, at an elevation of 1,053 meters above sea level, overlooking the breathtaking city of Chiang Mai. This sacred site, founded in 1429, boasts nearly 300 stairs leading up to the temple, where the Mon-style pagoda enshrines Lord Buddha's relics at its base. Officially known as "Praboromathat Doi Suthep Woravihan Temple," this temple stands as a testament to Thai Lanna art and Chiang Mai's cultural heritage. Both locals and tourists flock here to pay homage and revel in its beauty, while also enjoying the stunning views of Chiang Mai from its surroundings.

Next, venture to the enchanting Phra Tamnak Bhubing Rajanives Palace, a Thai-style architectural marvel nestled amidst lush greenery. The palace's serene setting features gardens, streams, ponds, and vibrant flowers that create a picturesque landscape. The highlight, however, is the astounding variety of roses that bloom in impressive sizes and colors, a sight that leaves visitors captivated. During the colder months, the palace is transformed into a veritable paradise garden, where hundreds of rose variants compete for attention, exuding delightful scents that permeate the entire area.

Continue your adventure to Doi Pui Village, home to the Hmong hill tribe, situated within the Doi Suthep Pui National Park at

an altitude of 1,658 meters. The village is surrounded by a captivating panorama of tall trees, pine forests, and the locals' vegetable, fruit, and winter flower gardens. The winter months between December and January are particularly enchanting, as the mountains are adorned with the blooming wild pink Himalayan cherry blossoms, a mesmerizing spectacle. The village also offers a viewpoint where tourists can marvel at the intricate arrangement of the mountains in the distance.

Lunch at the restaurant.

Explore the heart of Chiang Mai city with a visit to Wat Chedi Luang Worawihan Temple, an ancient and grand temple steeped in history. One of the largest and oldest temples in the region, it houses a sizable pagoda, though the top was partially damaged by a significant earthquake in 1545. Nevertheless, this Lanna-styled pagoda remains an invaluable gem of cultural identity. The temple, also known as Rajakudakan or Chotikaram Temple, was erected during the reign of King Prachao Sanmuangma in the 14th century. Over time, it has undergone numerous renovations and stands proudly as one of Chiang Mai's most revered pagodas.

To immerse yourself in the local atmosphere, visit Kad Luang or Warorot Markets, Chiang Mai's oldest and largest marketplace with a rich history spanning centuries. Here, both locals and visitors indulge in a delightful shopping experience, selecting from a vast array of fresh flowers, fruits, mouthwatering dishes, local delicacies, dried goods, fashionable clothing, cosmetics, and more.
