On the fifth day of your family trip, you start with a visit to Wat Phra That Doi Kong Mu temple, an essential place of worship in Mae Hong Son. Perched on top of Kong Mu Mountain, the temple comprises two pagodas of different sizes. The larger one was built by "Chong Thong Su" in 1860, while the smaller one was constructed by "Phraya Singhanatracha" in 1874. The hilltop location offers panoramic views of the town, surrounded by the enchanting beauty of mountains and valleys. Next, you explore two more temples in the area, Wat Chong Kham, and Wat Chong Klang, both located near the big swamp. These temples feature stunning Burmese-style architecture and house the revered Buddha image, Luang Paw To. Wat Chong Klang boasts an impressive display of Burmese wood carving dolls and large glass paintings depicting Buddhist history.

Continuing your journey, you visit the Su Tong Pae Bridge, the longest bamboo bridge in Thailand. It connects Suan Tham Phusama Temple and Kung Mai Sak village, crossing over picturesque paddy fields and canals. The bridge's classic

beauty against the lush greenery in the rainy season and the golden hues in winter create a memorable experience for visitors.

Reaching Doi Inthanon, you stand atop the highest peak in Thailand, soaring at an impressive altitude of 2,565 meters above sea level. Doi Inthanon is part of the Thanon Thongchai Mountain range, which stretches from the Himalayas, encompassing countries such as Nepal, Bhutan, and Myanmar. The diversity of climate and forest in the area allows you to experience rainforests, pine forests, and mixed forests at varying elevations. At the peak, you are rewarded with a breathtaking panoramic view that showcases the beauty of the surrounding landscape. The surroundings of the pagodas are adorned with winter flower gardens and various plants, adding to the beauty of the area. The cool weather prevailing throughout the year provides a comfortable ambiance, and the panoramic views from this vantage point are considered some of the most beautiful in Chiang Mai.

Continuing your exploration, you visit Wachirathan Waterfall, a magnificent single-tiered waterfall known for its outstanding beauty. The waterfall stands tall at 70 meters and flows all year round, making it one of the most beautiful waterfalls in Thailand. The station conducts research on flowers, ornamental plants, vegetables, fruits, and highland fisheries. The station contributes to the income generation of hill tribe farmers' families residing in

the surrounding villages. As the day draws to a close, you return to Chiang Mai, the vibrant city that has offered you an incredible array of experiences. You transfer to your hotel and stay overnight, reflecting on the wonders of nature and cultural richness you've encountered throughout this amazing family trip.
