08:30AM. Pick up from the hotel

As you savor a delicious Yunnan feast, indulge in the exquisite Chinese tea, renowned as the finest in Mae Hong Son province.

Lunch at the restaurant.

Continue your journey to Baan Ruam Thai village, also known as Pang Oung. This Shan village offers a haven of peace and tranquility amidst the rugged mountain range. Be mesmerized by the "Switzerland of Thailand," a large reservoir surrounded by pine forests and vibrant winter flowers. The cool, refreshing air adds to the idyllic atmosphere, creating a truly unforgettable experience. Imagine the mesmerizing scene of the pine forest bordering the spacious reservoir, embraced by the mountain range; the mist floating above the lake in the cool morning air; and the explosion of colorful flowers throughout the year.

Ascend to the peak of Kong Mu Mountain and pay your respects at Wat Phra That Doi Kong Mu temple, the most revered place of worship in Mae Hong Son. This sacred site comprises two magnificent pagodas, each with its own history. The larger pagoda, built in 1860, stands tall alongside the smaller one, constructed in 1874. Next, explore the historical Wat Chong Kham and Wat Chong Klang temples, both situated adjacent to a large swamp. These ancient temples, adorned with beautiful Burmese-style architecture, house the revered Buddha image known as Luang Paw To. In Wat Chong Klang, be captivated by the intricate Burmese wood carvings and the large glass paintings depicting fascinating Buddhist stories. As the day draws to a close, settle in for a restful night in Mae Hong Son, carrying with you the memories of captivating landscapes, diverse cultures, and enriching encounters.

DAY 02 Mae Hong Son Trekking (2-3hrs) / Long Neck Karen Tribe Village (Hotel / Breakfast / Lunch)

Breakfast at the hotel

Next, embark on a trek up a steep mountain, taking approximately one hour to reach the summit. As you ascend, be rewarded with breathtaking panoramic vistas of the surrounding mountains, creating a truly unforgettable spectacle. Enjoy a delicious lunch box at the peak, savoring the moment amidst the stunning scenery. After your lunch break, continue your journey to the fascinating Long-Necked Hill tribe village. This tribe, originally from Myanmar, has settled in Thailand for generations and still carries on its unique traditions. Witness the women adorned with their signature brass neck rings, a symbol of their cultural identity. Immerse yourself in their way of life and gain insights into their rich heritage. As your journey concludes, a car will be waiting to transport you back to Mae Hong Son town. Reflect on the day's adventures, filled with encounters with nature and diverse cultures, as you settle in for a restful night.

DAY 03 Mae Hong Son Chiang Mai: Doi Inthanon National Park / Royal Pagodas / The Royal Agricultural Station Inthanon / Wachiratharn Waterfall (Breakfast / Lunch)

Breakfast at the hotel
