Embark on a cruise to marvel at the natural beauty and observe the local way of life along the Mekong River's

banks. As one of the world's crucial rivers, the Mekong originates from the Tibetan Plateau, meandering through China, Laos, Myanmar, and Thailand's Golden Triangle region. Serving as a vital lifeline for communities on both sides, the Mekong River fosters cultural and economic connections before flowing into the South China Sea in Vietnam. With a total length of 4,880 kilometers, the Mekong River weaves a tale of nourishment, connectivity, and shared existence.
